Sandalwood Plant is semi parasite, it requires host for growth. There are 16 varieties of Sandalwood worldwide.

Indian variety is known as "Santalum Album". It has a higher commercial value than any other variety. Santalum Album is known as Queen of Sandalwood.

India and Australia are the leading producers of sandal wood in the world. The current production across the world accounts for only one fourth of the global market demand.



Sandalwood trees are found in Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Himachal Pradesh, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Manipur, Orissa, Punjab, Tamilnadu, Telengana and Uttarakhand In India. However, majority of it is found confined to state plantations in Karnataka, Kerala and Tamilnadu. There is a very high demand for sandal wood across the World.

Naturally Grown Sandalwood takes 30 years to be ready for harvesting, whereas intensive cultivation in organic methods takes 12 to 14 years.



Australia today is the only significant global producer of sandalwood, with 18,000 ha of plantation. Although its native variety, Santalumspicatum, is facing a decline, the country took up plantation of the Indian variety Santalum album. The commercial value of Santalum Album and its essential oil is very high due to its use in cosmetics, pharmaceuticals, chewing scented Tabaco, mouth freshener, aroma therapy, soap industries & perfumery. Indian Sandalwood has about 90% Aromatic value while Australian has about 30% only.


NEARBY TOURIST ATTRACTIONS LOCATION MAP










